COMMITTEE REPORTS:

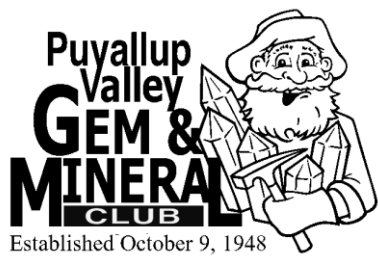
