COMMITTEE REPORTS:

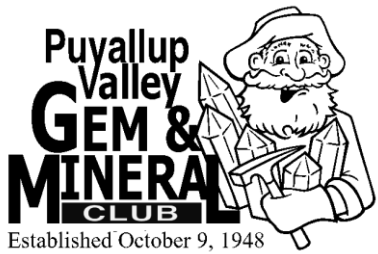
